

Format 1: Using the Stellar Phoenix Macintosh Bootable DVD

User can use bootable Digital Versatile Disc (DVD) of the Stellar Phoenix Macintosh 3.5 software to recover data. User can insert the DVD of the software and run the recovery process without installing the software. This helps, in case, computer is not booting from hard disk or operating system is not working. In these cases, user can recover data by using the Stellar Phoenix Macintosh 3.5 bootable DVD.

In order to run the bootable DVD on computer startup, user will need to configure the computer such that on computer startup the bootable DVD runs automatically. The minimum requirements to run the Stellar Phoenix Macintosh Bootable DVD:

- DVD drive
- 1 GB RAM

The following options are available that can be used to run the bootable DVD automatically on computer startup:

Press Keyboard C Key

Using this option user can start the computer directly through DVD drive. This means that the computer will boot through the bootable DVD. To run the bootable DVD on computer startup by using C option:

1. Insert the Stellar Phoenix Macintosh 3.5 bootable DVD in DVD drive.
2. Restart computer.
3. Press the **C** key. Computer will boot by using the bootable DVD.
4. The License Agreement screen appears on system startup. Click **I Agree** button. The Recovery Options window of the Stellar Phoenix Macintosh v3.5 software opens automatically.

System Preferences... Option

User can use this option to start the computer by using DVD drive. This option changes the startup disk of the computer. Changing the startup disk means changing the boot preferences of computer. This option requires that operating system should be working properly. To change the boot preferences by using System Preferences... option:

1. Click **Apple** icon and select **System Preferences...** to open System Preferences window.
2. Insert the Stellar Phoenix Macintosh 3.5 bootable DVD in DVD drive.

3. Under System pane, select **Startup Disk**. All the available options such as, DVD drive, hard drive will be displayed that can be provided as booting option on computer startup.
4. Select the DVD drive option.
5. Click **Restart....**
6. The License Agreement screen appears on computer startup. Click **I Agree** button. The Recovery Options window of the Stellar Phoenix Macintosh v3.5 software opens automatically.

Keyboard's Option key

User can change the startup disk by using the keyboard's Option key such that all the available options that can be used to boot the computer will be displayed when the computer starts. To use the option key to change the startup disk:

1. Insert the Stellar Phoenix Macintosh 3.5 bootable DVD in DVD drive. Restart computer.
2. Press the **Option** key.
3. All available options such as, DVD Drive, hard drive will be displayed by using which the computer can be booted.
4. Select the DVD drive option to boot the computer by using the CD drive.
5. The License Agreement screen appears on computer startup. Click **I Agree** button. The Recovery Options window of the Stellar Phoenix Macintosh v3.5 software opens automatically.

Format 2: Using the Stellar Phoenix Macintosh v3.5 Bootable DVD

A bootable Digital Versatile Disc (DVD) runs automatically when the computer starts. This requires that the boot preference of computer should be changed to DVD drive.

User can use bootable Digital Versatile Disc (DVD) of the Stellar Phoenix Macintosh 3.5 software to recover data. User can insert the DVD of the software and run the recovery process without installing the software. This helps, in case, the computer is not booting from hard disk or the operating system is not working. In these cases, user can recover data by using the Stellar Phoenix Macintosh 3.5 DVD. To start the Stellar Phoenix Macintosh v3.5 software by using bootable DVD:

1. Insert the Stellar Phoenix Macintosh v3.5 bootable DVD into DVD drive. If OS is working then computer startup disk can be changed to DVD drive by using the System Preferences option of Mac OS. To change the computer startup disk, click **Apple** icon and select **System Preferences** to open System Preferences window. Under System pane, select **Startup Disk**. All the available options such as, DVD drive, hard drive will be displayed that can be provided as startup disk on computer startup. Select the DVD

- drive option. Click **Restart....** The License Agreement screen appears on computer startup. Click **I Agree** button. The Recovery Options window of the Stellar Phoenix Macintosh v3.5 software opens automatically.
2. Restart the computer and choose one of the following:
 - Press the **C** key. Computer will boot by using the DVD drive.
 - Press the **Option** key. All available options such as, DVD Drive, hard drive will be displayed by using which the computer can be booted. Select the **DVD drive** option to boot the computer by using DVD drive.

 3. The License Agreement screen appears on computer startup. Click **I Agree** button. The Recovery Options window of the Stellar Phoenix Macintosh v3.5 software opens automatically.

Note: User can also change the boot preference from the operating system if the OS is working. Click **Apple** icon and select **System Preferences** to open System Preferences window. Under System pane, select **Startup Disk**. All the available options such as, DVD drive, hard drive will be displayed that can be provided as booting option on computer startup. Select the DVD drive option. Click **Restart....** The License Agreement screen appears on computer startup. Click **I Agree** button. The Recovery Options window of the Stellar Phoenix Macintosh v3.5 software opens automatically.

Creating the Stellar Phoenix Macintosh v3.5 Bootable DVD

User can create the bootable DVD of the Stellar Phoenix Macintosh v3.5 after downloading the software from the Web site. The bootable DVD helps in recovering data in cases such as:

- Computer is not starting
- Mac Operating System is not working

In such cases, user can use the bootable DVD to start the computer by using the bootable DVD of the Stellar Phoenix Macintosh v3.5. After starting the computer, the Recovery Options window of the Stellar Phoenix Macintosh v3.5 software will open automatically. Using this window user can recover and save data to another location.

Requirements to create bootable DVD:

- A blank DVD
- DVD writer
- Any working Macintosh Operating System

To create the bootable DVD of the Stellar Phoenix Macintosh v3.5 software:

1. Download the SPMAC.dmg file and save it to the desired location.
2. Insert a blank DVD in the DVD drive.
3. Click **Go | Utilities** and select **Disk Utility** to open Disk Utility window.
4. Click **Burn**. The Select Image to Burn dialog box opens. Navigate and select SPMAC.dmg file, which is downloaded from Web site.
5. Click **Burn**. After successful burning the bootable DVD of Stellar Phoenix Macintosh v3.5 software will be ready to use.

Note: Any other DVD burning software may also be used to burn bootable DVD.
